Class 3 SAMPLE OF AUTUMN SOWN HARD WHEAT, most suitable for Milling Purposes

Class 4 SAMPLE OF AUTUMN SOWN SOFT WHEAT, most suitable for Biscuit Milling Purposes

Class 5 SAMPLE OF AUTUMN SOWN WHEAT, most suitable for Feed Purposes

Class 6 SAMPLE OF SHORT OATS

Class 7 SAMPLE OF OIL SEED RAPE

Class 8 SIX WHITE POTATOES UNWASHED

Class 9 SIX RED POTATOES UNWASHED

Class 10 TWO SWEDES, any top, Untrimmed

Class 11 TWO FODDER BEET, RED OR ORANGE, As grown, untrimmed

Class 12 TWO FODDER BEET, ANY COLOUR OTHER THAN RED OR ORANGE YELLOW, As grown, untrimmed

Class 13 HEAVIEST ROOT 'SWEDE OR FODDER BEET'

Class 14 THREE HEADS OF KALE, roots dressed

Class 15 SIX STALKS OF FIELD BEANS

Class 16 TALLEST THISTLE

Class 17 SAMPLE OF SILAGE 5kg minimum, judged on appearance

Class 18 HALF A BALE OF NATURALLY DRIED SEED HAY.

Class 19 HALF A BALE OF NATURALLY DRIED HAY OTHER THAN SEED
