Part-Breds are not eligible unless entered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB.

Quality rounds of most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS **Qualifying or Life** members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern.

The show is a qualifier for the NPS Area 4 Northern Breeders in Hand Supreme Championship, Sponsored by "SUPREME PRODUCTS. The champion and Reserve from the riding Pony Breeding, Hunter Pony Breeding and Mountain & Moorland in hand will qualify for the Final to be held on Bank Holiday Monday in August 2019 at the NPS Area 4 Summer Show.
